## Is Eid al-Adha and Hajj Connected?

- Ramadan and Eid al-Adha began 2<sup>nd</sup> year of Hijrah
- Hajj became Obligatory in <u>9th Year</u> (AH) After Hijrah
- Eid al-Adha is Fixed to your local moon date of 10<sup>th</sup> Dhul Hijjah and Not Hajj

## Takbir al-Tashriq:

"And remember Allah during numbered days." (2:203)

From Fajr of 9th Dhul Hijjah to Asr 13th Dhul Hijjah. (Saturday Fajr – Wednesday Asr)

Qurabni/Udhiya – Established Sunnah; "A reward for every hair on the skin/strand of wool of the sacrificed animal." [Bukhari]. Animal be free of defects/diseases.

- The minimum age is six months for a sheep; one year for a goat; two years for a cow; and five years for a camel.
- Sacrifice yourself, eat a third, third in charity and store a third.
