• Everyone shall stand before Allah to be judged for every deed, therefore one should hasten towards good. Weekly deeds are presented to Allah son Mondays and Thursdays, while the whole year's deeds are raised in Sha'baan.

Usama Ibn Zaid "I said, 'O Messenger of Allah, sometimes you fast, and you hardly ever break your fast, except two days which, if you are fasting, you include them in your fast, and if you are not fasting, then you fast them on your own.' He said, 'which two days?' I said, 'Monday and Thursday.' He said, 'those are two days in which deeds are shown to the Lord of the worlds, and I like my deeds to be shown (to Him) when I am fasting'".

Raising Deeds To Allah Almighty

"the gates of Paradise are opened on two days, Monday and Thursday. In these two days, every servant (of Allah) who does not associate anything with Him is forgiven except the person in whose (heart) there is rancour against his brother. (About them) it would be said, 'look towards these two until they have made a reconciliation'."

(Muslim)

know that the year's deeds are lifted to Allah, the Almighty, in the month of Shaaban, about which the Prophet pbuh said, "that is a month to which people do not pay much attention, between Rajab and Ramadan. It is a month in which the deeds are taken up to the Lord of the worlds, and I like that my deeds be taken up when I am fasting." (Musnad Ahmad/Sunan An-Nisai)

"indeed, Allah looks down on the night of the middle of Shaaban and forgives all of His creation except for the polytheists and those with grudges." (Ibn Habban/Tabrani/Bayhaqi)

- Therefore, we must make a conscious effort to cleanse our hearts and put things right between people for this is amongst of the best of acts. The Messenger said, "Shall I tell you what is better than prayer, fasting and giving for charity?" They said, "Yes." He said, "mending discord." (Musnad Ahmad)
- Truly, having a pure heart and showing forbearance are amongst the causes of winning Allah's forgiveness and seeing one's rank raised by degrees. Allah, the Almighty states, "and let them pardon and overlook. Would you not like that Allah should forgive you? And Allah is Forgiving and Merciful." (24:22)

- Did you protect your hands and feet from falling into haram? How much good did you enjoin? How much evil did you forbid? How many hours did you waste?
- How I wonder, what our position is in the eyes of Allah when our deeds are raised?
- Which of us will be brought closer and embraced, and which of us will be distanced and punished?
