1. Against Allah - Kufr — Disbelief — Shirk — Polytheism and Hypocrisy "Indeed, polytheism is the greatest injustice." (31:13) — إِنَّ الشَّرْكَ لَظُلْمٌ عَظِيمٌ

2. Against The Creation Of Allah

"The cause is only against the ones who wrong the people and tyrannize upon the earth without right. Those will have a painful punishment." (42:42)

3. Against Oneself, Sinning - Transgressing Limits And Order Of Allah إِنَّ الْإِنسَانَ لَظَلُومٌ كَفَّارٌ

Indeed, mankind is most unjust and ungrateful. (14:34)
