وَلَقَدْ خَلَقْنَا الْإِنسَانَ وَنَعْلَمُ مَا تُوَسُّوسُ بِهِ نَفْسُهُ وَنَحْنُ أَقْرَبُ إِلَيْهِ مِنْ حَبْل الْوَرِيدِ

"And We have already created man and know what his soul whispers to him, and We are closer to him than his jugular vein." (50:16)

Some relationships change with distance, sometimes those people who are supposed to be close to us don't know us at all. Sometimes you want to tell someone something, but the words get stuck in your throat, so they misunderstand. And at other times, the fear of being hurt prevents us from being close to people and others.

"And when My servants ask you concerning Me – Indeed I am Qareeb." (2:186)

For all those times you have wondered whether Allah sis near or far, Allah doesn't use an intermediary to answer this question. He does not instruct the Prophet signal - Tell Them". He answers you directly in the verse above: "I Am Near."

For all those times you have wondered whether Allah ﷺ hears you, He answers: اإِنَّهُ سَمِيعٌ قَرِيبٌ (34:50) [Indeed, He is Hearing and near,"

For all those times you have wondered if He has heard the silent Du'a of your heart, He answers: إِنَّ رَبِّي قَرِيبٌ مُّجِيبٌ - "Indeed, my Lord is near and responsive," (11:61)

Allah Al-Qareeb & The Power Of Du'a

Sometimes even our best friend does not understand what we are going through.

Allah is so close to us He hears our thoughts, our reflections, our unuttered questions and our secret *Du'as*

Know That Allah ﷺ Is With You: One of the fruits of being close to someone is feeling safe and understood. And if you have ever felt lonely وَهُوَ مَعَكُمْ أَيْنَ مَا كُنتُمْ الْكِنتُمْ (57:4) with you wherever you are,"

Al-Qareeb and Ramadan "If you feel far from Allah ﷺ, ask yourself: who moved?"

Ramadan comes to quench our thirst. It does not matter how far you have been. It does not even matter if you have never felt that closeness to Him; Allah tells us that He is near because He wants you to learn to feel that. He gives us Ramadan so that we can recharge and reconnect – so make use of this month for that purpose.

Gaining Nearness To The One Who Is Near

- 1: Understand His Names You can only be close to people whom you know well
- 2: Prayer The root of the word Salah is Sila, which means 'a connection'
- 3: Ask Him: "I respond to the invocation of the supplicant when he calls upon Me. So let them respond to Me (by obedience) and believe in Me that they may be guided." (2:186)
- **4: Be There For His People**: Being close to Allah **means being close to His creation.** Visit the sick, stand in solidarity with the oppressed & you will find nearness to Him.

"The supplications of three persons are never turned away: a just ruler, a fasting person until he breaks his fast, and the supplication of an oppressed person" (Ibn Majah)
