From its trials are that peoples hearts will become hardened, the heart will die, such that they will be deprived and denied the pleasure and ecstasy of truly worshiping Allah

- Men and women will go through the motions and rituals of worships but will have no sense of fulfilment, enjoyment, or joy
- Reflect on your Salah, on Jumu'ah, Ramadan; the ease Hajj and repetition of Umrah. When do people turn up for Jumu'ah prayers? Is there Lazah?

Then your hearts became hardened after that, being like stones or even harder. (2:74)

 The Sahabah enjoyed a great lazah, fulfilment and enjoyment of worshipping Allah. They had a true and tangible feeling, a true ecstasy of worshipping Allah – do we?

From its trials for humanity is the corruption of the family, in wealth, children and destruction of the homes

- This is a more serious Fitna, the first one was localised to the individual and now this extend to the nucleus of society, the family, the home
- Today there is no longer understanding within the home, there is constant bickering, quarrelling, perpetual altercations and arguments
- The home that was supposed to provide the happiness and peace is no longer providing that – Allah remind us what the home is actually for:

And Allah has made for you from your homes a place of rest (16:80)

And of His signs is that He created for you from yourselves mates that you may find tranquillity in them (30:21)

I created spouses for you so that when you look at her/him it takes away
the depression, and stress of the day, now when we look at them the
depression starts

We must wake up and realise how close we are to the HOUR – and prepare
