"When his Lord said to him, "Submit", he said "I have <u>submitted</u> to the Lord of the worlds." (2:131)

Ibrahim faced the interests of family/community vs his belief

"And We had certainly given Ibrahim <u>sound judgement</u> before, and We were of him well-Knowing" (21:51)

• Ibrahim struggled against his community, their beliefs, practices and idols. He debated, reasoned and then demolished their idols, his community's rejection and rage led them to burn him alive, but his belief protected him.

"Allah said, "O fire, be coolness and safety upon Ibrahim" (21:69)

 He mission doesn't stop there, he moves on to debate with the tyrants and desposts of his time in Egypt and then to Shaam. He invites people to submit themselves to Allah and to reject idolatry

Have you not considered the one who argued with Abraham about his Lord [merely] because Allah had given him kingship? When Abraham said, "My Lord is the one who gives life and causes death," (2:258)

- It is not long however before he is commanded yet again by Allah to pack his luggage and immigrate to another land, along with Haajar and his son Ismail.
- Mecca a dry, desolate, lifeless and lonely part of the world, lacking every single basic resource for human life. There, he is commanded to leave Haajar and Ismail, and walk away. Without hesitation or any second thought, he submits

Our Lord, I have settled some of my descendants in an uncultivated valley near Your sacred House, our Lord, that they may establish prayer. So make hearts among the people incline toward them and provide for them from the fruits that they might be grateful. (14:37)

And who is better in religion than one who submits himself to Allah while being a doer of good and follows the religion of Abraham, inclining toward truth? And Allah took Abraham as an intimate friend. (4:125)

By the Dawn; By the ten Nights; (89:1-2)

"On no days is the worship of Allah desired more than in the (first) ten days of Dhul Hijjah. The fast of each of these days is equal to the fast of a whole year, and the worship of each of these nights is equal to the worship of Laylatul Qadr." (Tirmidhi)

The Prophet ** was asked about the fast of the day of Arafah. He said, "It compensates for the (minor) sins of the past and the coming year." (Ibn Majah)

"A person should neither clip his nails nor cut his hair until he performs qurbaani". (Ibn Majah)

- The reciting of Takbeer al-Tashreeq after every Fard Salah from the Fajr of 9th Dhul Hijjah to the Asr of 13th Dhul Hijjah
- The Qurbaani/Sacrifice to be performed on 10th, 11th or 12th Zul Hijjah.
- If you have saving equivalent to the Silver Nisaab Threshold (£280) or Gold Nisab Threshold (£2800), then you must do Qurbani
