- Shukr is performed both publically and privately Shukr is the Izhaar al-Ni'mah revealing the blessing and the opposite of Shukr is Kufr Ikhfa al-Ni'ma, the concealment of the blessing. كَفَرَ الشَّيْءَ : سَتَرَهُ ، غَطَّاهُ كَفَرَ عَلَيْهِ
- 1. We can never count Allah's Blessings but we should at least attempt to. Be ever grateful to Allah if for everything that you possess including your wealth, health, status, intellectual abilities and life.

Even if you try to count Allah's blessings, you could وَإِن تَعُدُّوا نِعْمَةَ اللَّــهِ لَا تُحْصُوهَا never compute them" (16:18)

The Biggest Ni'ma to mankind is the Prophet

لَقَدْ مَنَّ اللَّـهُ عَلَى الْمُؤْمِنِينَ إِذْ بَعَثَ فِيهِمْ رَسُولًا مِّنْ أَنفُسِهِمْ يَتْلُو عَلَيْهِمْ آيَاتِهِ وَيُزَكِّيهِمْ وَيُعَلِّمُهُمُ الْكِتَابَ وَالْحِكْمَةَ وَلَا كَانُوا مِن قَبْلُ لَفِي ضَلَالٍ مُّبِينٍ

Certainly did Allah confer [great] favour upon the believers when He sent among them a Messenger from themselves, reciting to them His verses and purifying them and teaching them the Book and wisdom, although they had been before in manifest error. (3:164)

• 2. Shaytan's primary mission is to make human beings ungrateful: From the very beginning of the human being's creation, the issue of gratefulness and vs ungratefulness has ensued. Remember when Satan refused to bow down to Adam and made a vow:

"Then I will certainly come to them from before them and from behind them, and from the right-hand side and from the left-hand side, and You (Allah) shall not find most of them thankful." (Al-Araf 7:17)

• 3- The opposite of Shukr (gratitude) is Kufr (disbelief):

"Then remember Me; I will remember you. Be grateful to Me, and do not reject Me" (2:152)

• 4- We thank Allah so for our own benefit: If you are ungrateful, Allah so is unaffected. If you become grateful, then you benefit yourself.

And whoever is grateful is grateful for [the benefit of] himself. And whoever denies [His favour] - then indeed, Allah is Free of need and Praiseworthy. (31:12)

• 5- Shukr leads to Allah's pleasure: The Prophet said: "Allah is pleased with His servant if, when he eats something, he thanks Allah for it, and when he drinks something, he thanks Allah for it" (Muslim).

If anyone says "I am pleased with Allah as Lord, with Islam as religion and with Muhammad & as Apostle" Paradise will be his due. (Tirmidhi)

• 7- Shukr is a quality of success in this life and in the Hereafter: The Prophet said: "There are four qualities, whoever is given them has truly been given the best in this world and the next. They are: a grateful heart a remembering tongue, an enduring body, and a faithful wife that helps him with his faith." (Tirmidhi)

 8- Shukr leads to abundance in Allah's favours: If you appreciate Allah's favours, Allah's reward for your gratitude is unlimited and unconditional.

And [remember] when your Lord proclaimed, 'If you are grateful, I will surely increase you [in favour]; but if you deny, indeed, My punishment is severe.' (14:7)

- The Prophet ﷺ was always grateful for the ease and hardships in his life "Should I not be a grateful slave?" (Bukhari) أَفَلاَ أَكُونُ عَبْدًا شَكُورًا
- You as children/students/siblings/couples/parents/citizens/Muslims have so much to be grateful for, especailly in this country we must show our thankfulness and gratitude to people as well to Allah
- Shukr is **not restricted to a specific time or place**, but it can be celebrated on times/days/moments of blessings. Its expression must remain **constant**, **positive and beneficial**. Whenever you remember a blessing or are reminded of a blessing then you should turn to Allah ******

9- Three ways to express Shukr: Shukr of the heart (Oalb), which is achieved by harboring and intending

- Shukr of the heart (Qalb), which is achieved by harboring and intending good for all of Allah's creation.
- Shukr of the tongue (Lisan), which involves celebrating the praises of Allah, such as utterance of Alhamdulillah, and expressing gratefulness to Allah with our tongue.
- Shukr of the limbs (Jawarih), which is fulfilled by using our external senses to do good. Every time Allah gives us a blessing, we must use it in a way that benefits humanity and that pleases Allah.
