“O mankind, indeed We have created you from male and female and made you peoples and tribes that you may know one another. Indeed, the most noble of you in the sight of Allah is the most righteous of you. Indeed, Allah is Knowing and Acquainted.” (49:13)

- Our religion has always called for building fruitful relationships amongst people based on kindness, good deeds and words.

## Intercultural Communication

- Therefore Muslims must interact with all of mankind, different religions, ethnicities, languages, colours and countries. Treating communities and people in kindness , to establish tolerance, compassion, justice, loyalty and honesty as well as patience, forbearance, kindness, and giving for charity.

“Allah does not forbid you from those who do not fight you because of religion and do not expel you from your homes - from being righteous toward them and acting justly toward them. Indeed, Allah loves those who act justly.” (60:8)

- Yes we have different beliefs but for that we simply state “**for you is your religion, and for me is my religion.**” however we must still interact with one another.
- Only through peaceful coexistence will lives be protected, rights safeguarded, compassion and peace will prevail and everyone will enjoy peace of mind as well as a decent and stable life. It is also a means of combating extremism and its destructive consequences.
